## **LOST PROPERTY - Wednesday Mornings 9.10am**

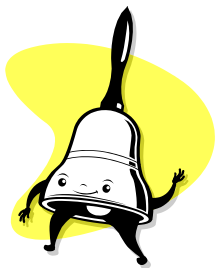
